WEST MEETS EAST — (BOB) AMERICA FORGES MUSICAL ALLIANCE WITH (LENKA DUSILOVÁ) CZ

(San Francisco CA) – Café du Nord will host one of the Czech Republic's most famous singers, Lenka Dusilová, and San Francisco's own Bob America in a concert and double CD release party on June 15, 2007. The show commemorates the U.S. release of Dusilová's Angel (Czech Grammy)-winning CD, "Mezi Svety" (Between Worlds), and Bob America's self-titled debut CD.

Long a fixture on the Czech music scene, Lenka Dusilová has established herself as one of Europe's up-and-coming singer/songwriters. As well as winning the 2005 Angel for album of the year, "Mezi Svety" also brought Dusilová her second Angel as female vocalist of the year (the first was in 2000). She was voted best female vocalist of 2000, 2001, 2002 and 2003 by the readers of the influential Czech music magazine, "Report."

Since 2000, Dusilová, in addition to her solo work, has recorded and performed with the Czech Republic's preeminent folk-rock band, Czechomor. She appeared on the group's breakthrough Album, "Promeny" (Transformations), produced by punkster-turned-classical composer Jaz Coleman, who characterized her as "a great talent." Since releasing "Mezi Svety" in 2005, Dusilova has toured the United States on her own and with Czechomor. Wowing crowds at the Kennedy Center in Washington, Los Angeles, San Francisco, New York, Miami, Chicago, Dallas, Detroit and Denver, the Fall 2006 Dusilova/Czechomor tour established Dusilova on this side of the Atlantic as an important new force in world music.

Bob America joins the ranks of such revolutionary musical Bobs as Bob Seger, Bob Dylan, and Bobby Darin. After writing songs for years in solitary obscurity under another name, he emerged as Bob America, recorded a 12-song CD, and embarked on a performing career.
